1) Details from the scene

Anything that you collected from the scene can be helpful, including contact names, vehicle information, insurance policy numbers, and more.

2) Photos

3) Witness statements

If you have contact information for anyone who may have witnessed the accident, share this with your attorney. Testimony from an impartial witness can be invaluable.

4) Medical records and bills

To build your case, your attorney must convey the toll that the accident took on your health and your pocketbook. You can bolster your case by providing your lawyer with all pertinent medical records and bills, to include prescription receipts.

These costs can be covered by the insurance company, so it behooves you to give your attorney a detailed record of your medical expenses.

5) Lost wages

If your ability to work was compromised by the accident, make sure to provide your attorney with documentation showing days off of work or inability to perform certain tasks due to your injuries.
